**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** to all interested persons within Bastrop and Lee Counties, Texas:

That the Board of Directors of the Lost Pines Groundwater Conservation District ("Lost Pines GCD") will hold a special-called public meeting to adopt the desired future conditions ("DFCs") for the Sparta, Queen City, Carrizo, Calvert Bluff, Simsboro, and Hooper Aquifers underlying Bastrop and Lee Counties, Texas, in accordance with Section 36.108(d-4) of the Texas Water Code.

The Lost Pines GCD is one of five groundwater conservation districts located wholly or partially within Groundwater Management Area 12 ("GMA 12"); the other districts in GMA 12 include Brazos Valley Groundwater Conservation District, Fayette County Groundwater Conservation District, Mid-East Texas Groundwater Conservation District, and Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District. At a GMA 12 joint planning meeting held on May 25, 2017, the district representatives voted to adopt DFCs for the groundwater resources in GMA 12.

The DFCs adopted by the district representatives of GMA 12 are described in terms of average drawdown levels for the Sparta, Queen City, Carrizo, Calvert Bluff, Simsboro, Hooper, and Yegua-Jackson Aquifers, for each groundwater conservation district located within GMA 12. For Lost Pines GCD, the proposed DFCs are based on the average drawdown measured from January 2000 through December 2069 and include the following:

Besides accepting public comment and discussing and adopting the DFCs, no other substantive agenda items will be included at this special-called board meeting. The Lost Pines GCD board may have other hearings and board meetings posted for this same date, immediately following this special-called board meeting, each with their own notice and agenda.

Any person who desires to appear at the meeting and present comment or other information on the adoption of the DFCs may do so in person, by legal representative, or both. Limits may be placed on the amount of time that each person is allowed to present verbal comments, but written comments may also be submitted.
