**LOST PINES GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT
RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF HOUSE BILL 1633 FILED BY REPRESENTATIVE
STAN GERDES AND SENATE BILL 624 FILED BY SENATOR KOLKHORST**

WHEREAS, the Lost Pines Groundwater Conservation District (the "District"), was created in 1999 by Senate Bill 1911, 76th Texas Legislature, pursuant to Section 59, Article 16 of the Texas Constitution and Article 7880-3c, Texas Civil Statutes (now Chapter 36, Texas Water Code); ratified by the 77th Texas Legislature in 2001; and confirmed by voters in Bastrop and Lee counties in November 2002;

WHEREAS, the District was created by the Legislature to provide for the conservation, preservation, protection, recharging, and prevention of waste of groundwater in regard to aquifers within the boundaries of the District;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Water Code § 36.057 the District's Board of Directors (the "Board") shall be responsible for the management of all affairs of the District;

WHEREAS, Representative Stan Gerdes and Senator Lois Kolkhorst have consistently supported the Lost Pines Groundwater Conservation District;

WHEREAS, Representative Gerdes and Senator Kolkhorst have filed bills aimed at the purposes of Groundwater Conservation Districts, including House Bill No. 1633 and Senate Bill No. 624, identical bills related to the criteria considered by groundwater conservation districts before granting or denying a permit or permit amendment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lost Pines Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors hereby express their support for the above-mentioned bills filed by Representative Gerdes and Senator Kolkhorst.


